

EQUALITY POLICY: OHM SPORTS

Any claims should be reported in writing to the Club Chairman. Where any claims are proven, we will ensure that the practice is stopped and subsequent sanctions will be imposed, as appropriate.

We will continue to follow Football Association and Middlesex County FA guidance in the area of equality, which will support us in our commitment to ensuring that our Equality Policy is purposefully evaluated, monitored and developed.
